

PAC Business Meeting Summary - On March 21 the participants of the PAC Business Meeting vote to authorized the purchase of a commercial building under \$600,00 to facilitate the focus and purpose of our Disaster Recovery & Development warehousing needs and to provide additional Church Office space as needed. This funding will come from our fire insurance monies. There was also an enabling action to move ahead with the purchase of another house from insurance funds up to a purchase price of \$499,000. This house will serve as the residence for our new Youth Pastor as well as providing an expanded area of our campus to be used for our youth.



Adventist Health Feather River Vaccine Opportunity - On Fridays from 9:00 am to 12 noon, the clinic will be offering COVID vaccines to those 50 years of age and older. To make an appointment call 530-872-2000. Plan to be there for at least 30 minutes as they ask you to remain in place for a 15 minute observation period immediately following your vaccination. Each week there are “no shows” and that leaves AHRF with extra vaccines that would be available to those over the age of 50 seeking a vaccination, but do not have an appointment. If you find yourself with a free Friday morning and need the vaccine, call the clinic’s main line listed above and get on their drop-in list. The clinic is located at 5125 Skyway (bottom floor) in Paradise. Ask for Bev Roberson for more information.
