We invite you to remember in prayer those who are affected by the *Dixie*, *River*, and *Caldor* fires this week. These situations are continuing to develop and unfold. If you would like to reach out in support of those affected by the *River* and *Caldor* fires, please consider a donation to the *NCC Disaster Relief Fund*, which provides cash support for basic human needs to SDA members and those connected to NCC churches and schools during the first 14 days after a mandatory evacuation. If you would like to donate in support of those affected by the *Dixie* fire, we invite you to visit the *Paradise Chamber of Commerce* for a list of those entities coordinating efforts for Dixie Fire Relief.

Leoni Meadows (the camp property for the Northern California Conference—site of summer camp and year-round youth, church, and family retreats) was one of the first areas to be impacted during the *Caldor* fire. Late Monday night, the staff and firefighters were required to evacuate the area as the fire approached. During the night and early in the day on Tuesday, people near and far who have been touched by the ministry of *Leoni Meadows*, lifted their prayers on behalf of the camp. It was several prayerful hours later, after the fire had passed through the area, that a few staff members were allowed to return and photos and updates started to post on Facebook. We are so grateful to God for what miraculously remains standing at *Leoni Meadows*: the Leoni House, the Lodge, the Meadow View Inn, several cabins, the train, and some staff housing. Sadly, there were losses as well: the nature center, craft building, camp headquarters and office, barn, wagons, a few cabins, and some staff homes were lost in the fire. We invite you to remember in your prayers the individuals impacted by this fire as well as the ministry of *Leoni Meadows*.
